Categories for original work: Surface design, mixed media fiber, felting, quilting, knotting, weaving, knitting, fiber sculpture, basketry, sculptural paper and needlework. We encourage two-and three-dimensional works including suspended and sculptural pieces.

Out of the Loop

The West Hartford Art League is pleased to announce a call for entries for its first broad-scale fiber arts show to showcase out-of-the-ordinary, contemporary fiber works that advance traditional techniques through radically innovative interpretations. In other words, definitely out of the loop! Entries can include (but are not limited to): surface design, felting, quilting, knotting, weaving, knitting, fiber sculpture, basketry, handcrafted paper and needlework. We encourage two and three-dimensional works including sculptural pieces.

The juror will be looking for exceptional craftsmanship as well as "out of the box" thinking, design and execution.

Eligibility: All work must be the original work of the artist and must have been completed within two years of the entry deadline and not previously exhibited in a WHAL juried show. All work must be at least 50% fiber or textile that has been hand-manipulated. All entries must be installation-ready with appropriate hanging rods or mounting devices if necessary. No complex installations.

All submissions must be on premise by October 29th. No exceptions.

Entry Fee: Fee for each entry: \$20 non-members, \$15 members.

Up to four pieces may be submitted. Make checks payable to West Hartford Art League. Fees are non-refundable. Payment and forms must be received at 69 Raymond Road, West Hartford, CT 06107 by Thursday, October 21, 2010. If submitting digitally, you must include a CD with your entry form and check.

Digital Entries: A Full view digital image is required iJPEG format with 200 dpi resolution. CD must be PC compatible. Unreadable CDs will be disqualified. Files should be named as follows: first initial, last name, abbreviated title, number [1-4]. Label your CD (hand print) with name, phone number, e-mail address, and number of images. Images incorrectly identified or mislabeled will be disqualified. Digital image title must match the title on the entry form. CDs will not be returned. CD must be received for jury by Thursday, October 21, 12 noon.

Hand Delivered Entries: Artwork will be received: **October 28th from 5-7 p.m. and October 29th from 11-1 p.m.** in the gallery at Blue Back Square, 69 Raymond Road, WH. Artwork will not be accepted before or after the dates noted. We WILL NOT accept work unless the required paperwork is received by the due date noted on the entry form.

Show dates: November 11 - December 5th. Opening reception: Thursday November 4, 2010, 6-8 p.m.

Close of Show: The show closes on December 5th at 4 p.m.. Work may not be removed before the close of the gallery the last day of the show. Work not picked up by date is left at owners' risk.

Sales: All artwork must be for sale. A 30% commission is taken on all sales.

Liability: Every reasonable care will be taken in the handling and storage of the works submitted to the Exhibit, but the West Hartford Art League will not be responsible for loss or damage no matter how it may occur, whether such work is in storage, on display, or in transit.
