1. Untitled. Artist: Charles O. Perry. Corner of South Main Street and Memorial Rd. Installed on loan, September 2008.
2. 21 murals. Artist: Walter O.R.Korder with assistance by Hall High School students (within Town Hall, 50 South Main Street)
3. Noah Webster. Artist: Boston born Korczak Ziolkowski. Chiseled on site in the early 1940's. (South Main St. in front of the library)
- 4, 5, 6. Three horses, Artist: Karen Petersen. Memorial Drive in Blueback Square. Installed on loan, September 2008.
- 7,8,9. Three sculptures, Artist: Michael McLaughlin. Duffy School library. 95 Westminster Drive. Purchased in 2007.
10. Bear sculpture, Artist: Peter Busby. The first commissioned piece in West Hartford Art League's Public Art Program. West Hartford Art League grounds. 37 Buena Vista Road. Installed in April 2008.
11. Outdoor Labyrinth and Memorial Garden, First Church of Christ Congregational, West Hartford Center. (12 South Main Street)
12. ArtWalk 5th Anniversary Mural. Artists: Students from Hall and Conard High Schools. Jerrys Artarama. New Britain Ave, Elmwood. Produced in September 2008.
13. Chaos, Artist: Tim Prentice. Public land on Buena Vista Road. Installed on loan in September 2008.
14. CT Veterans Memorial, West Hartford Center. (northeast corner of Main Street and Farmington Ave.) Dedicated in 2006.
