Schedule, Rules and Registration

Categories: All ages

Supplies: The first fifty contestants will be given one box of chalk supplied by Blick Art materials. Artists may bring additional washable chalk to use. Artists may also bring and use water spray bottles, knee pads, rags, paper towels and paint brushes. No other materials will be allowed.

Location: The parking lot and surrounding sidewalks on LaSalle and Arapahoe Roads in West Hartford Center. All artists will be assigned a space. Space is not negotiable.

Date / Start / End time: Saturday September 11. Start: 9:00 a.m. Artists must complete all work by 3:00 p.m.

Judging: Judging will be done by a panel of three jurors who will judge on design, execution, color use and originality.

Artwork: Artwork must be appropriate for all age groups. No advertising or logos will be allowed. Any work considered offensive or inappropriate will be disqualified.
